JSSAHERM policy on Scholarships

JSS Academy of Higher Education and Research Mauritius (JSSAHERM)

POLICY ON SCHOLARSHIPS

1. JSSAHERM's Scholarships

JSSAHERM Scholarships demonstrates the institution's commitment to reward students who have obtained excellent results at Higher School Certificate or who come from low income families; and wish to enrol on full-time undergraduate study at JSSAHERM.

JSSAHERM Scholarships Schemes

- i. Based on <u>Performance at HSC*</u>- 25% discount on tuition fees for the first year of the undergraduate programme [3 A⁺ in Advanced level and 2 A at Subsidiary level at the Cambridge Higher Secondary Education]
- ii. Based on <u>Performance at end of academic year</u> 25% discount on tuition fees for the academic year of the undergraduate programme [Score 90% or above and be the topper]
- iii. Based on <u>Social Register</u>**- 10% discount on tuition fees for each academic year and a monthly allowance of MUR 5,000 during the time the student attend classes [2 semesters of 15 weeks in every academic year].

2. Eligibility criteria

To be eligible to receive the JSSAHERM Scholarship, applicants must:

- i. Submit an application for same
- ii. be a minimum of 18 years of age on 1 February of the year of commencing the scholarship
- iii. be able to satisfy the admission requirements of JSSAHERM;
- iv. have scored 3 A⁺ in Advanced level and 2 A at Subsidiary level at the Cambridge Higher Secondary Education for the JSSAHERM Scholarship (Merit); OR have scored a minimum of 24 credit points at the Cambridge Higher Secondary Education AND be from a low-income household figuring on the social register of the Republic of Mauritius for the JSSAHERM Scholarship (Social);

3. Exceptions

- i. JSSAHERM may consider granting scholarships on other grounds than mentioned herein.
- ii. JSSAHERM reserves the right to change the scholarship schemes
